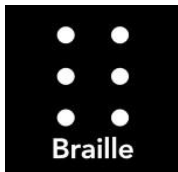
AUDIO DESCRIPTION PERFORMANCES

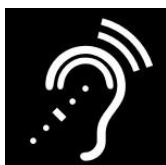
